### **Key Themes**

The key themes of the Conference are:

- **Digitization & digitalization**: Exploring the role of digital tools in enhancing trail sustainability and managing trail databases. Climate resilience and trail infrastructure
- **Overtourism**: Implementing strategies to mitigate the effects of high visitor numbers on popular trails using digital innovations.









### **Objectives**

- To foster understanding and use of digital technologies in trail management, enhancing both access to information and the sustainability of trail environments.
- To foster use of digital technologies (apps and on-line maps) by trail users.
- To create a platform for exchanging best practices in dealing with overtourism through digital means, ensuring the longevity and health of natural landscapes.
- To discuss and potentially redefine trail definitions to align with modern needs and ensure recognition and funding from the EU.

#### **Conference outcomes:**

- **Best practices database:** Establishment of a comprehensive digital database detailing sustainable practices and solutions to overtourism on trails.
- **Digital tools for trail management:** Showcase of digital tools like Webmapp EUMA and ERA E-paths that assist in the effective management of trail data.
- Enhanced trail sustainability: Development of real-time monitoring systems to assess environmental impacts and manage visitor flows effectively.
- **EU policy alignment:** Recommendations for updates to trail definitions that could aid in achieving EU recognition and support for funding.
- **Network building:** Strengthening connections between trail managers across Europe to foster collaboration and shared learning.

### Submission of the papers

- 20/05 **Deadline for submission of the abstracts.** The authors should submit the title, summary, and keywords in English. Summarize up to 300 words.
- 04/06 Deadline for notifying authors about the **acceptance of the paper.** The Executive and Editorial Committee will carry out the selection of papers.
- 24/06 Publication of the final program, including the abstracts.
- 20/08 Deadline for submission of the presentations.
